

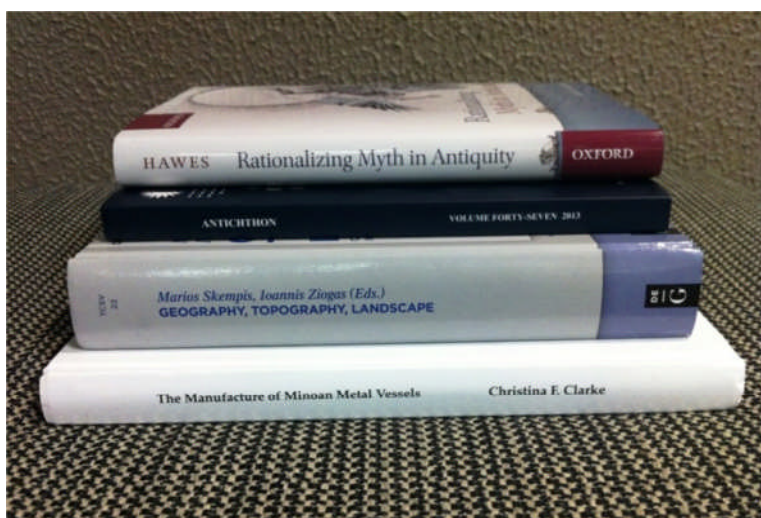
LAUNCH OF FOUR BOOKS – CENTRE FOR CLASSICAL STUDIES
